§ 133-25.2 Hazardous wastes.

- C. It shall be unlawful for any person or entity, as owner, occupant, lessee or agent, or in any other capacity, to store, deposit, place, maintain, suffer or cause or permit to be stored, deposited, placed or maintained on any unimproved and/or porous land surface, any motor vehicle that may spill, release, discharge, or leak from such motor vehicle hazardous waste, hazardous materials or unacceptable waste in any form, including but not limited to, any petroleum hydrocarbon, including gasoline, oil, transmission fluid and/or any other hazardous or regulated materials or contaminants unless said premises is in compliance with all the rules and regulations pertaining to the storage of motor vehicles and potential associated substances hazardous or acutely hazardous to public health, safety or the environment and has a certificate of occupancy and license or permit for use of the premises for the storage of motor vehicles and potential associated hazardous materials or waste, issued by the Town of Babylon and as applicable; any other local or New York State Agency.
